

SEDAN CHAIR RALLY 2002 - Further Guidelines

SAFETY

All 'riders' in the chair **MUST** wear a safety helmet with a chinstrap at all times. The wearing of knee and elbow pads is recommended. The chair seat must be on a level with the carrying frame to ensure stability of the chair when being carried.

Teams will not be allowed to start the race if the rider is without adequate head protection and will be disqualified if seen without the helmet during the race.

Chairs considered to be unsafe at the time of judging will not be allowed to start the race, e.g. sharp protruding edges (internal or external), or particularly poor construction.

JUDGING GUIDELINES

Refer to the main sheet on Judging Guidelines when building your chair – but the following is also important - Please ensure that your chairs theme is easily recognisable, for example a sign stating your chosen theme that can be left in the judging area.

CHAIR RE-USE

Chairs that have been seen at previous rallies will not be marked highly. This excludes the bare carrying frame. I.e. you should build a new chair each year!

TEAM SIZE

A maximum of 7 in each team, one of which is to be carried around the course at all times (except when instructed by a Race Marshall).

NO LEADERS OR SUPPORTERS TO BE WITH THE TEAM DURING THE RACE. This will lose your team points.

RIDER OUT OF CHAIR

Any riders seen out of their chair between checkpoints will have points deducted (except when instructed by a Race Marshall).

SCORING OF THE CATEGORIES AND RACE

There are 6 categories – Best designed & Constructed, Best Dressed, Most Topical, "Wow" factor, Best Finishing, Fastest.

For 1 st place in a category	15 points
For 2 nd place	12 points
For 3 rd place	10 points

And down to 0.

No joint places will be awarded to the top 3 positions.

Checkpoint scores are out of 10 for each checkpoint. There are 5 checkpoints throughout the race.

There will be a bonus/mystery item that will need to be carried around the course keeping the object as complete as possible. A complete item handed in at the end will be awarded 10 points. Points will be awarded for bringing back the object, broken or in part.

So altogether: 90 points for effort prior to the race
50 points for the checkpoints
10 points for the bonus/mystery item
TOTAL: 150 points possible.
